A: Reservations for stays between now and May 31, 2020 will be automatically cancelled and fully refunded. No action is required by our guests. The guests will be notified by e-mail that their reservation has been cancelled and that any refund required has been processed.

### **Q: When can I re-book? When are you opening?**

A: George T. Bagby State Park & Lodge is currently taking reservations starting for arrivals on June 1, 2020. Because the safety and health of our employees and guests is our top priority, we will continue to monitor the situation and communicate any changes.
